Teacher

Each Teacher of the School plays an important part in shaping our students' learning. The Teacher acts as a role-model at all times by living and breathing the values of the Greek School of St. Athanasios; compassion, respect, perseverance and inclusion.

Duties and Responsibilities

1. Planning and delivering lessons according to the Curriculum, under the guidance of the Head Teacher.
2. Preparing appropriate learning material (worksheets, handouts) as necessary.
3. Identifying individual learning needs and styles and plan learning experiences that enable all students to achieve.
4. Providing the students who are absent with the necessary material in time for their future lesson preparation.
5. Supporting the school's needs and collaborating with the Head Teacher during the pupil exams for the Certificate of Attainment in Modern Greek Language.
6. Undertaking children supervision duties, along with the Site Officers, during the lessons' breaks, to secure children's safety.
7. Working as part of a team and collaborating with teachers, teaching assistants, volunteers, and the School Committee in a range of school activities.
8. Carrying out administrative and organisational tasks as required.
9. Participating in the organisation of the school's celebrations and cultural events.

Required Qualifications

1. Excellent command of Greek and English language.
2. Degree in Education, Greek Philology or similar.
3. Qualified Teacher Status.
4. Further qualification in a related area e.g. MEd, MA.

Required Experience

1. Teaching Greek as a second/ foreign/ heritage language.
2. Working with students across the age range.
3. Working with parents to support student outcomes.
4. Supporting positive behaviour and attitudes to learning.
